1. General description

240 Amp, logic level gate drive N-channel enhancement mode MOSFET in 175 °C LFPAK56 package using advanced TrenchMOS Superjunction technology. This product has been designed and qualified for high performance power switching applications.

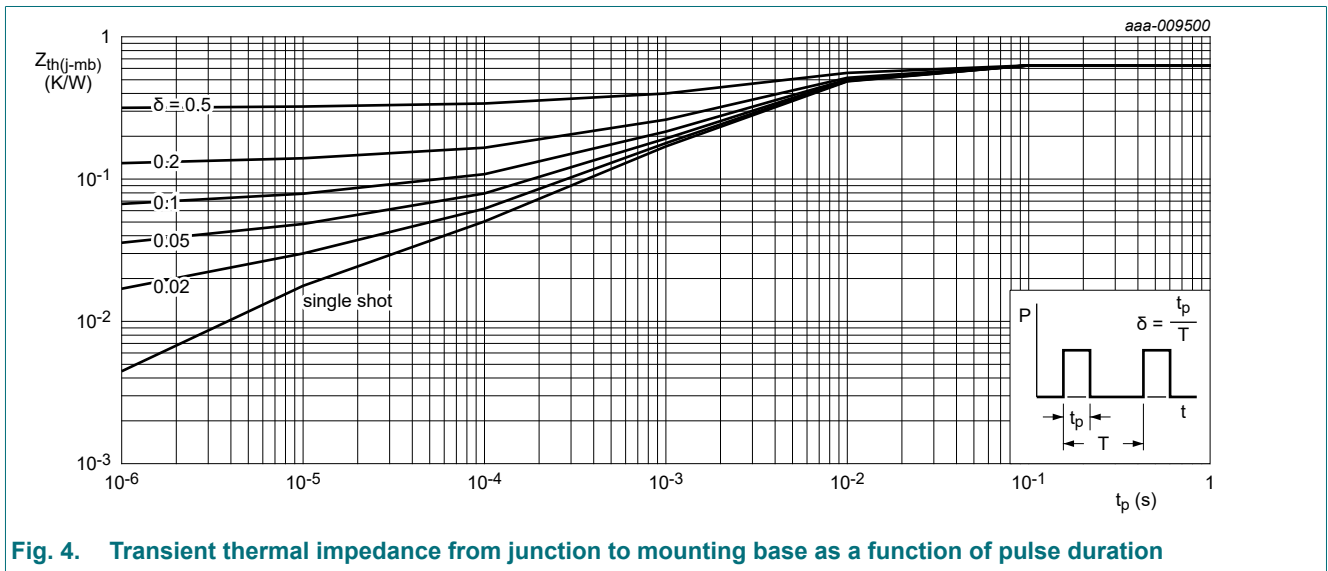

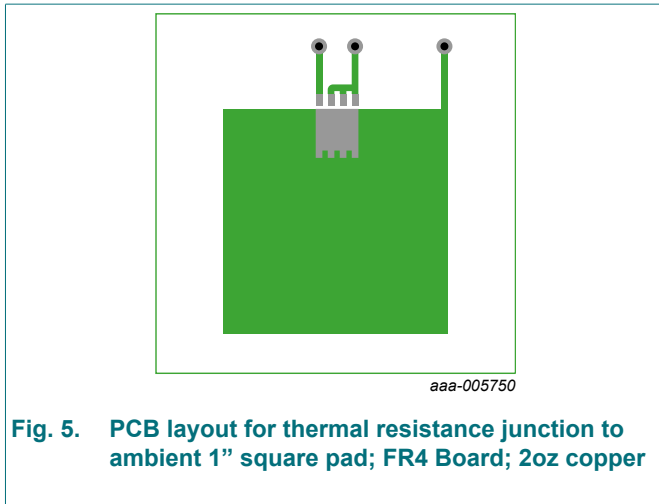


Fig. 5. PCB layout for thermal resistance junction to ambient 1" square pad; FR4 Board; 2oz copper

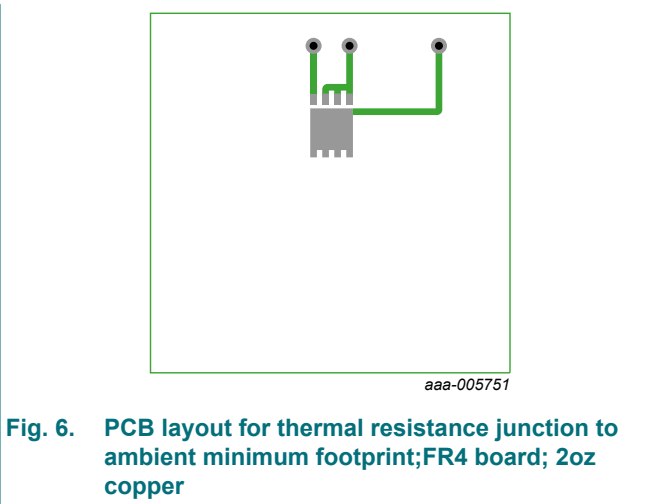


Fig. 6. PCB layout for thermal resistance junction to ambient minimum footprint;FR4 board; 2oz copper

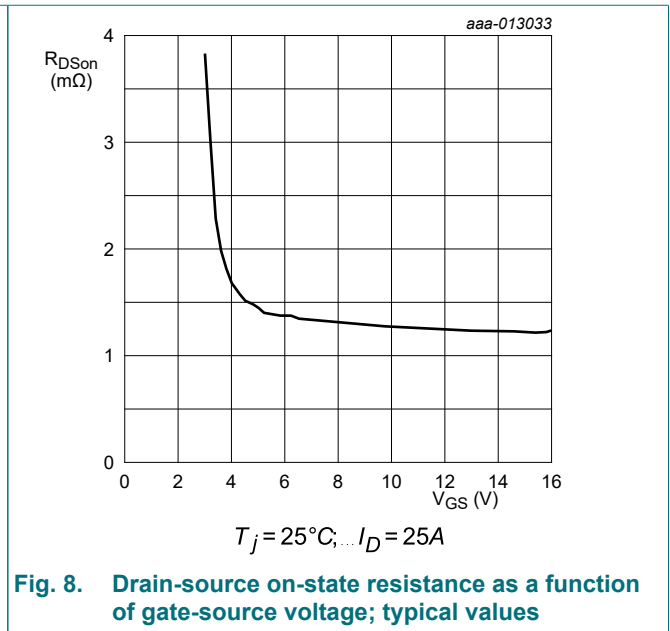
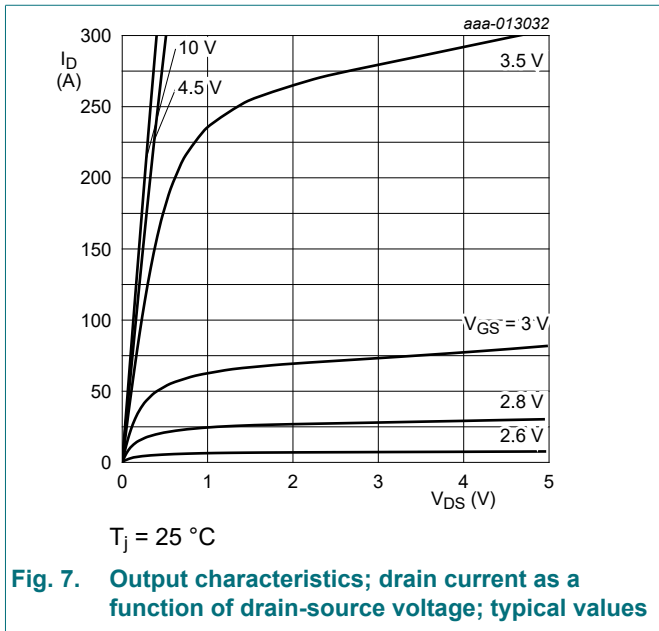

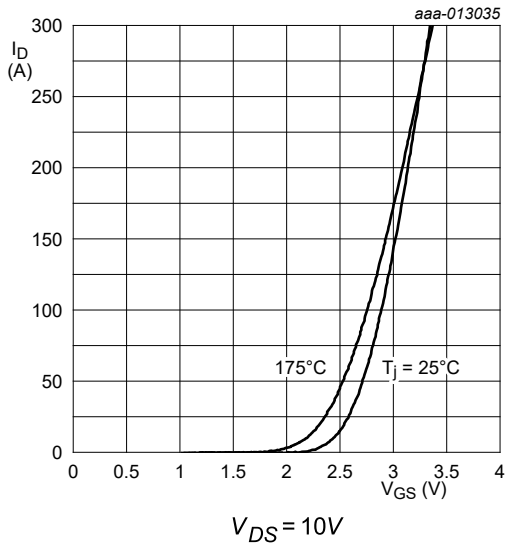


Fig. 9. Transfer characteristics; drain current as a function of gate-source voltage; typical values

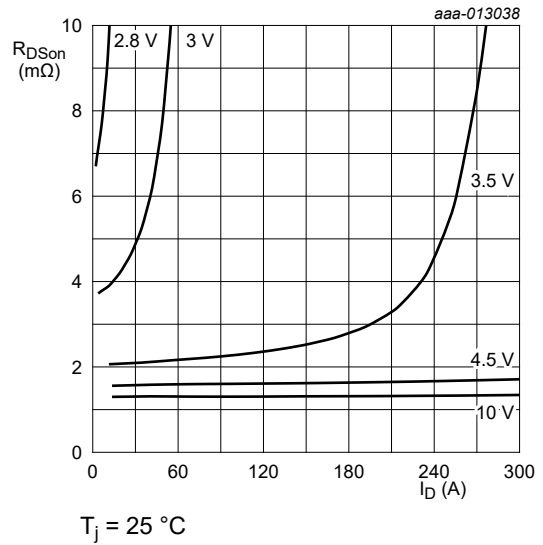


Fig. 10. Drain-source on-state resistance as a function of drain current; typical values

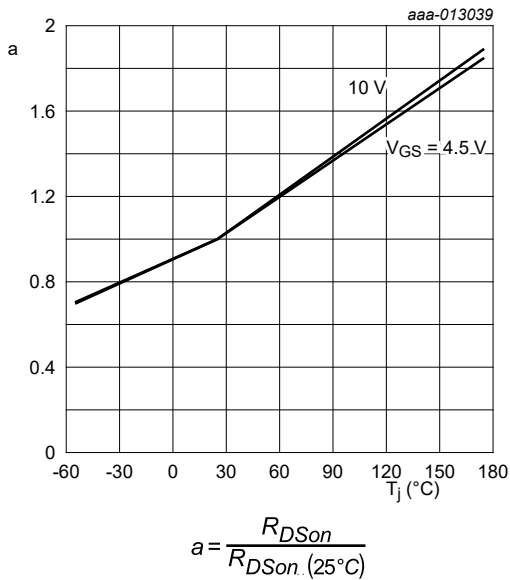


Fig. 11. Normalized drain-source on-state resistance factor as a function of junction temperature

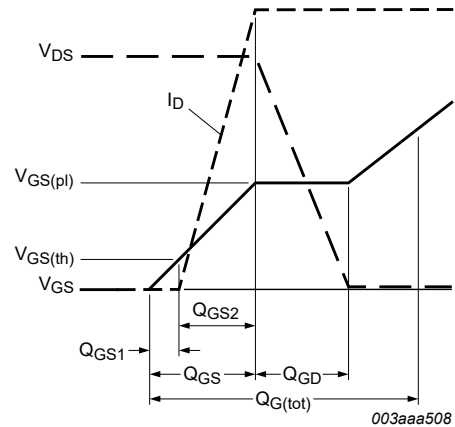


Fig. 12. Gate charge waveform definitions

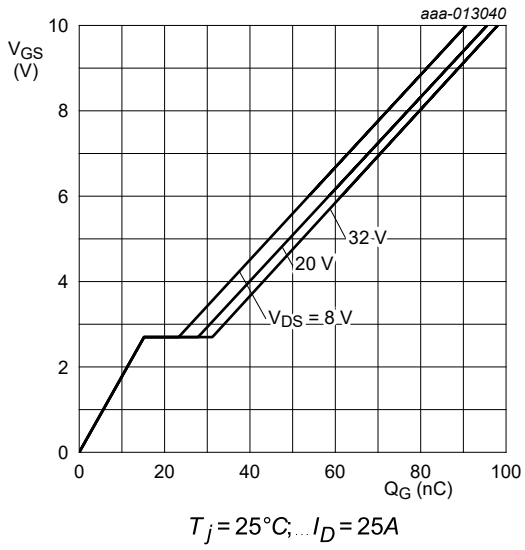


Fig. 13. Gate-source voltage as a function of gate charge; typical values

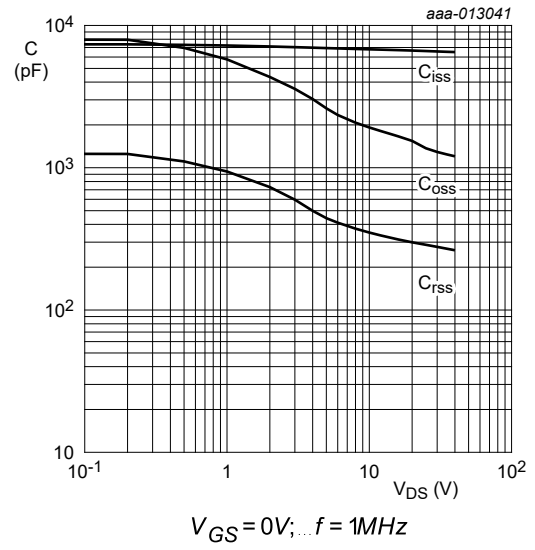


Fig. 14. Input, output and reverse transfer capacitances as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values

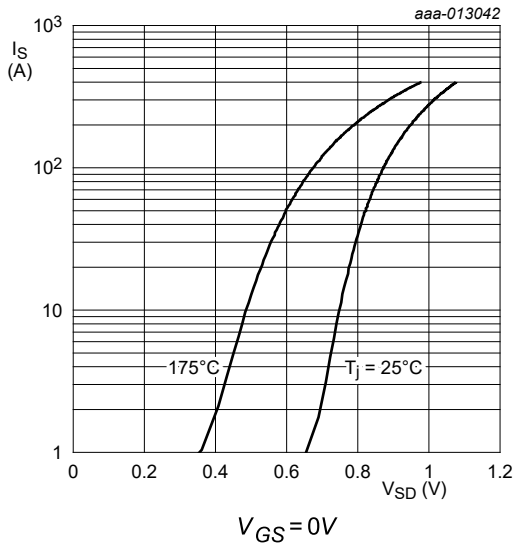


Fig. 15. Source current as a function of source-drain voltage; typical values

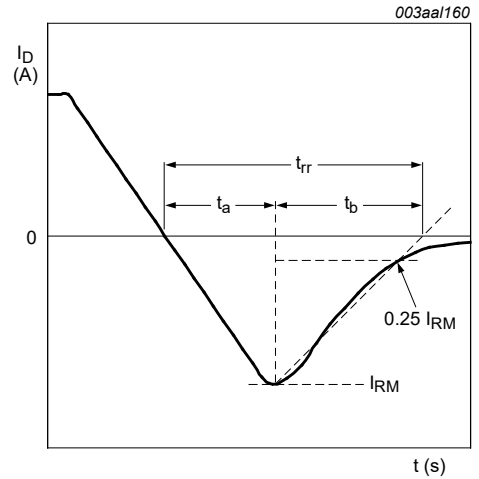


Fig. 16. Reverse recovery timing definition

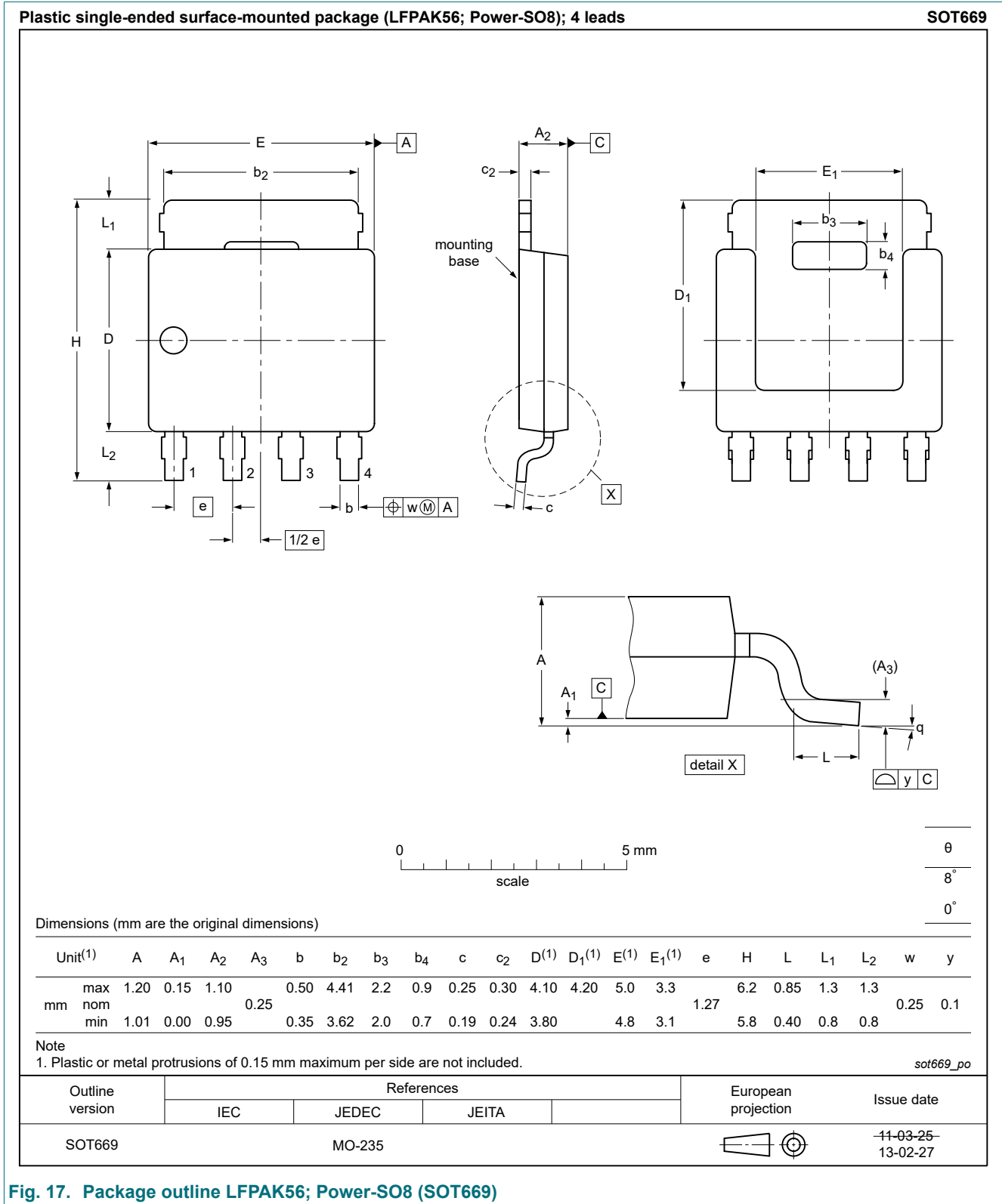


Fig. 17. Package outline LPAK56; Power-SO8 (SOT669)

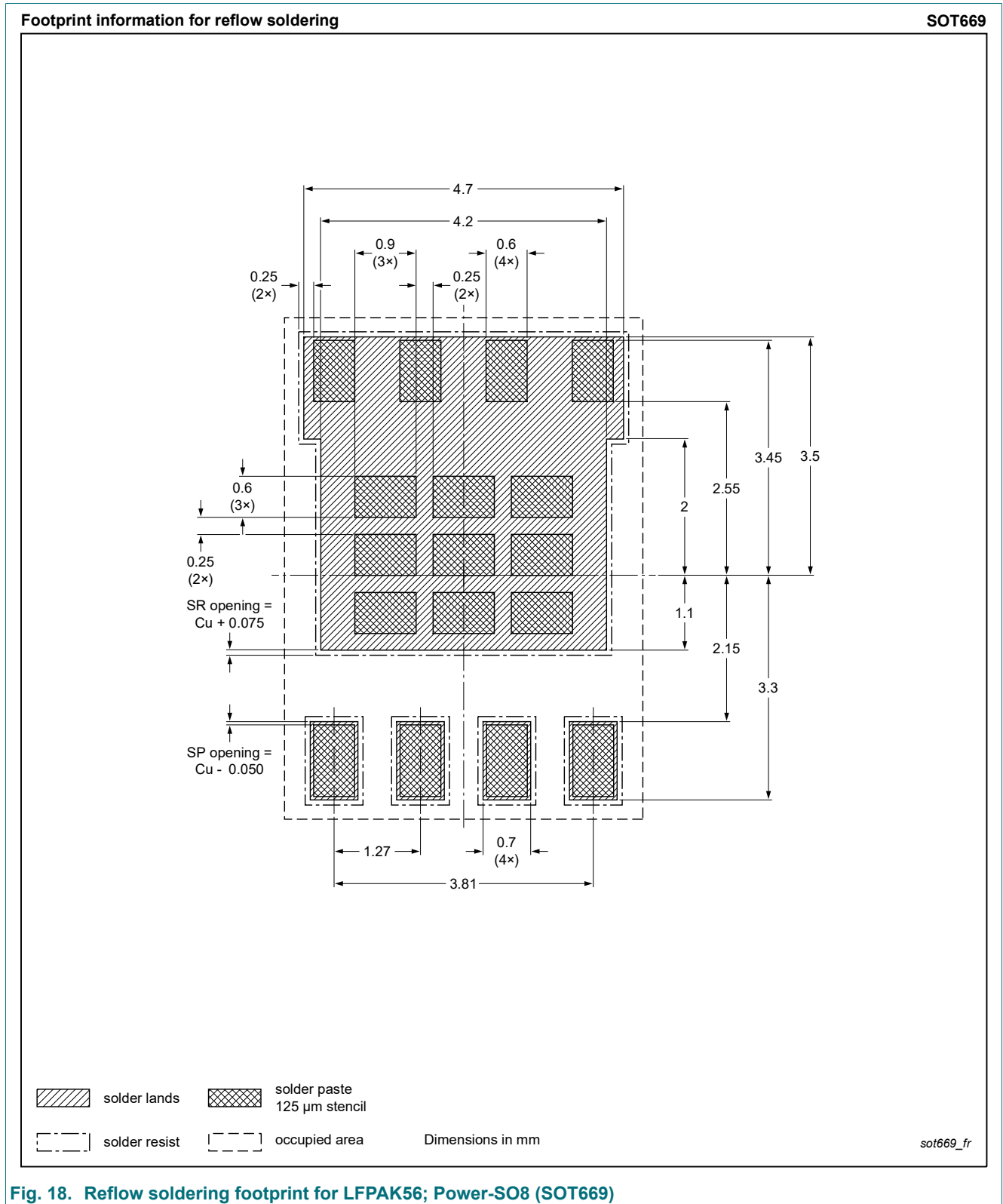
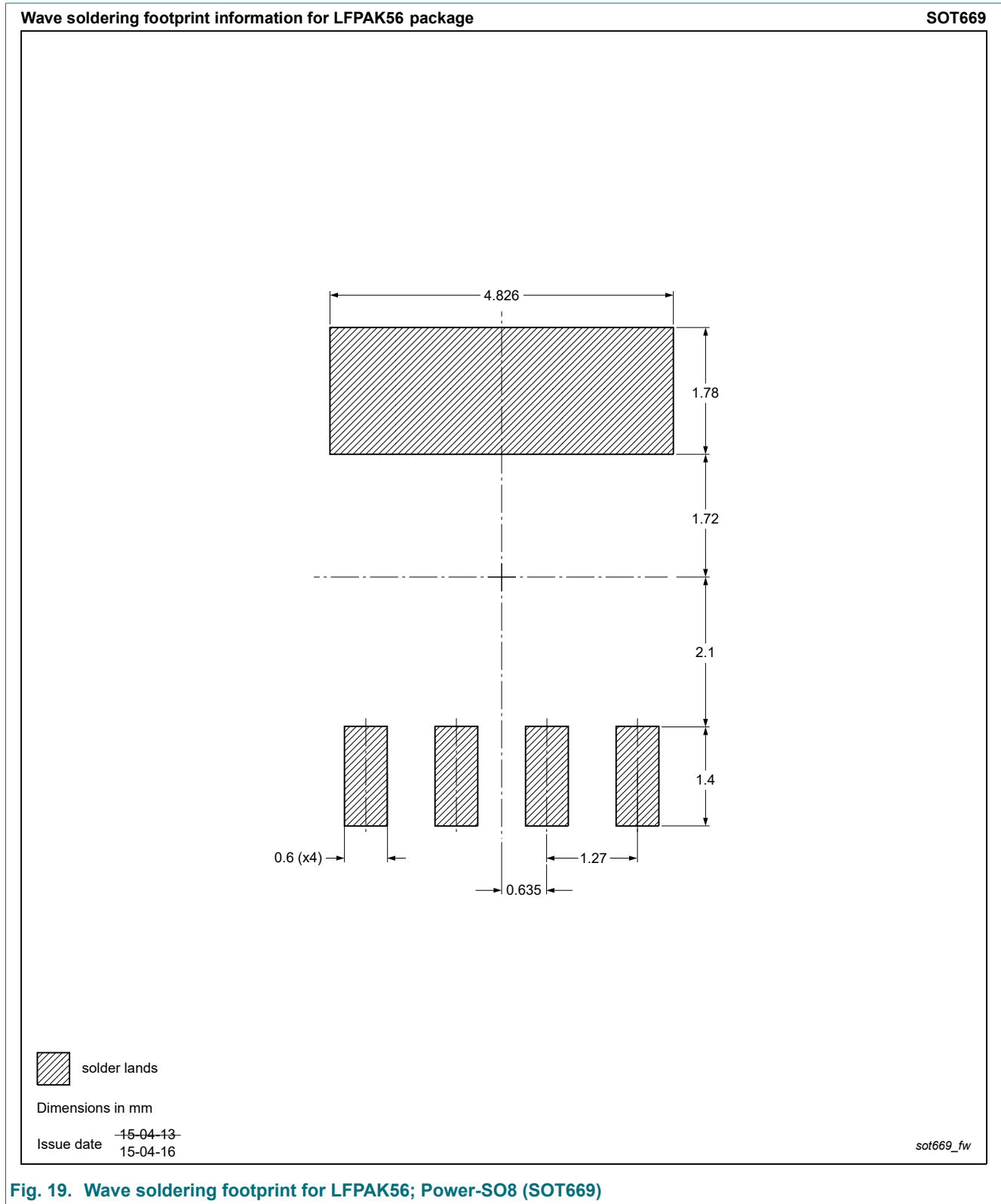


Fig. 18. Reflow soldering footprint for LPAK56; Power-SO8 (SOT669)
